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HOW TO ORGANIZE A BENEFIT EVENT WITH A BUSINESS IN YOUR COMMUNITY

January 2018 is <u>National Mentoring Month</u>, and one way Vermont mentoring programs are celebrating is by working with local businesses to organize benefit events in their local communities! These events will spread awareness about mentoring and support local mentoring programs. O FIND A PARTNER

Identify a few different potential local business partners and start reaching out. Make sure you collaborate with other mentoring programs in your area so you are not duplicating efforts.

- Reach out to a business that has supported your mentoring program in the past.
- Reach out to mentors and/or advisory council members who have connections to business owners or managers.
- Reach out to a business through its website information (research past benefits they may have done, find contact information, start a conversation).

O CREATE A PLAN

Design a few ways for the business and you to benefit from the event. Pitch your ideas to the selected business partner and make sure you agree on a clear plan and a date.

- **Pitch:** The business donates a percentage (10-20%) of proceeds or amount of each item sold that day/night/week.
- **Pitch:** The business provides a space for program to highlight mentoring throughout the night (i.e. a display table with promotional material and more information sign-up sheet)
- **Pitch:** A restaurant includes a mentoring insert in each menu or check throughout the night. Mentoring programs should design the mentoring insert to include a quick pull (i.e. quotes, a mentoring story, pictures, etc.) and push (call to action and contact information).

O PROMOTE YOUR BENEFIT EVENT

You did it! Now invite people to the benefit event at your business partner's location. Share with people the "who, what, when, where, why and how." Who is it benefiting? What do they need to do to *best* support you? When do they need to do it? Where do they need to go or be? Remind them why their support is important. How does your benefit event work? Give a shout out to your new business partner. This is a great "benefit" for your partner: free PR.

- Share with your mentors and advisory council members.
- ♦ Share in your personal and your mentoring program's social media posts, website blurbs, and e-mail blasts.
- ♦ Share through local outlets in your town (ex. school newsletter, local newspaper, Front Porch Forum).
- Share with word of mouth: show the people you share with easy ways for them to spread the word (i.e. invitations, social media posts, e-calendars, etc.)
